1. <u>Hand-Carried Merchandise.</u> We have been receiving different information from various US Customs Ports how to import hand carrier merchandise, such as type of information to be uploaded in DIS.

How will the port of Laredo handle these types of importations?

- 2. **Offshore Labor :** CBP informed the trade community in December that they cannot use offshore labor to transmit entries.
